Dental Project for Ocracoke

Ocracoke does not have access to full time dental services. The yearly Rotary 2-day dental clinic sees about 60 people every year. Because of the generosity of the island, about \$30,000 to \$40,000 worth of dental work is done in the two days costing only \$1,200. Baptist on Mission charges the club for expenses such as mileage. D7730 had been bearing the expense but was unable to for the 22-23 Rotary year when Morehead City Rotary Clubs stepped up.. With the continuing growth of those served, District 7730 is reaching out to other districts for donations, volunteers, and a permanent funding stream.
